

Proposal/Requirements for Polygraph Examination from Polygraph Services of Wisconsin LLC

Fidelity Examination – Cost is \$350.00 per person

Location – you must provide hotel/motel room or business location (secure room with power outlets, table, and two chairs, if windows – must have blinds, locking door). I will not conduct an examination in a private home or apartment.

The examination is audio/video recorded from the moment the examinee walks into the room. Kept in my files for 3 years with complete examination records.

Medical Condition(s) – will need medical clearance before exam is conducted for the following:

Heart attack, unstable angina, congestive heart failure, aortic aneurysm (chest or abdomen), deep vein thrombosis or bypass surgery.

Any condition in which the clients mental capabilities are limited in their decision making capacity.

Female client – Pregnant. Second trimester, to ensure safety of mother and child if the expectant mother is considered a high risk pregnancy. If the expectant mother is in her third trimester or is pregnant and has had any history of a miscarriage, I will not conduct the exam regardless if medical clearance is given until 2 months after delivery.

If currently experiencing a case of excessive coughing, bronchitis, pneumonia – need to wait until medical condition is resolved.

Reschedule Fee – \$100.00 if client shows up under the influence of any illegal or non-prescribed drug(s) or alcohol.

Note: This examination process covers only the period of your committed relationship (exclusive dating, engagement, and/or wedding). We will not cover prior relationships, as this is not a sexual offender history examination.

Items to be performed by Polygraph Services of Wisconsin, LLC

- I. I will review all pertinent information and conduct my pre-exam questioning before creating my examination question list.
 - A. What is the main issue that you want resolved?
 1. Having sex with (person's name)
 2. Using the internet (laptop/smart phone) for chat room sex
 3. Intimate contact without penetrative sex (mutual masturbation)
 4. Sharing intimate details with a third party
 5. Using work or cell phone to contact (person's name) for phone sex
 6. Paying for sex with an escort service
 7. Sex activity during a period of separation – very specific dates are needed
 8. ????? Be as specific as possible
- II. Conduct the exam as early as possible in the morning. If needed for the client's convenience – I can conduct the exam on the weekend or at a time which is best for the client. **Two to three hours** is needed for a proper exam.
- III. **Confession.** If the client confesses to the act in question – my report will reflect that response.
- IV. **If Deception Indicated (DI) is found.**
 - A. Do you want the client interrogated in the room **or**
 - B. Do you want me to dismiss the client and write up the report indicating my findings?
 1. If not indicated before the exam, I will release the client without conducting an interrogation, if they show Deception Indicated (DI).
- V. **Final Report.**
 - A. Report will be finalized within two business days after the exam.
 1. Report emailed to you **or**
 2. Sent via USPS with delivery tracking.

Day of the Examination

- I. **Examinee Provides.**
 - A. Required items must be provided.
 1. List of medications taking.
 2. List of jobs the past 10 years or to age 16 (whichever is shorter).
 3. Driver's license or any other available picture ID.
 4. **Must consent** to the examination being conducted.

Day before the Examination

- I. Preparation.
 - A. Normal sleep pattern before the examination.
 - B. All medications taken 24 hours before examination (**as prescribed**). No double dosing or medication(s) being withheld – I need the client in a normal state.
 - C. **No illegal drugs or alcohol 24 hours prior to the exam.**
